In accordance with this Court's opinion of this date, the judgment of the trial court is **AFFIRMED** in part and **REVERSED** in part.

We **REVERSE** that portion of the trial court's judgment granting summary judgment as to appellants Carl "Stacey" Neese, Individually and as Next Friend of L.N., C.N., L.N., and C.N., James Neese, David Neese, Jennifer Hughes, Mitzi Renfro, and Irl Hooper's claims for barratry under the original version of Government Code 82.065, breach of fiduciary duty, rescission, civil conspiracy, DTPA violations, and an accounting. In all other respects, we **AFFIRM** the trial court's judgment. We **REMAND** this cause to the trial court for further proceedings consistent with this opinion.

It is **ORDERED** that each party bear its own costs of this appeal.
